# The Luxembourg Protocol in the UK





As of 26<sup>th</sup> February 2016 the UK is now a Signatory to the Luxembourg Protocol to the Convention on International Interests in Mobile Equipment on Matters Specific to railway Rolling stock



## The Process from Signature to Ratification and UK Law

- ▶ What should we include?
  - ▶ 3 month Consultation Period
  - ▶ Collate responses and reflect
  - ▶ Ministerial agreement on content
  - ▶ Publish Summary of responses and conclusion



## What will it look like?

- ▶ Draft a Statutory Instrument (similar to Aircraft Equipment SI (2015 No.912))
- ▶ Technical Consultation on the draft SI
- ▶ Lay before Parliament
- ▶ Coming into force date?
