


The Luxembourg Protocol in the UK

As of 26th February 2016 the UK is now a Signatory to the Luxembourg Protocol to the Convention on International Interests in Mobile Equipment on Matters Specific to railway Rolling stock



The Process from Signature to Ratification and UK Law

- What should we include?
 - 3 month Consultation Period

- Collate responses and reflect
- Ministerial agreement on content
- Publish Summary of responses and conclusion



What will it look like?

▶ Draft a Statutory Instrument (similar to Aircraft Equipment SI (2015 No.912))

Technical Consultation on the draft SI

▶ Lay before Parliament

Coming into force date?
