
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# Experience of the Aircraft Registry

Started in 2006, with 500,000 registrations since, representing an estimated value of over half a trillion USD.

The Aviation Working Group estimates it will save the air transport industry USD 161 Billion USD between 2009 and 2030.

1. Return to the first search screen
2. Enter the full object details i.e. Manufacturer, Model Designator, Serial Number and object type.
3. Ensure that the format used is as provided by the manufacturer to the IR for similar objects.
4. Request an informational search and follow the subsequent instructions
